Flexible Timelines: Learners may complete the Program in 6-24 months depending on their schedule, interests, goals, and pace of learning / skill development.

Flexible Pathways: Common pathways include:

- 1. Foundations + 3 Electives + Practicum + Case Presentation Course = 6 courses
- 2. One Elective + Foundations + 2 Electives + Practicum + Case Presentation Course = 6 courses
